discussed briefly in a single chapter and in like manner a single chapter only has been devoted to a summary consideration of the condition of our literature at the end of the nineteenth century to arouse the student's interest in the authors as actual men the illustrations chosen have been confined to portraits and views and to facsimiles of manuscripts to enable him to see for himself the successive stages of the growth of american literature and to let him discover how the authors sometimes came one after another and sometimes worked side by side there has been appended also a chronological table of the chief dates in our literary history as mere text book instruction can never be an adequate substitute for the student's own acquaintance with the actual works of the authors discussed there have been annexed to every chapter bibliographical notes calling attention to the editions most suitable for the student's reading and also to the best biographies and to a few of the most suggestive criticisms from the prefatory note
