novel studies are the main practice used in my english language arts classroom over the years i began to question the effectiveness of these methods as i have observed students become disengaged with their learning while reading a whole class novel this study used a student survey focus groups and a self interview for my data collection methods to explore the effect novel studies have on students perception of their engagement and reading comprehension in my classroom the findings suggest novel studies are engaging to students with the pace of the novel genre of the novel and personal enjoyment having an impact of students engagement it has also found that a student s personal enjoyment of reading helps the student to have a better understanding of the novel and it can increase the overall reading comprehension of the novel this has implications for my classroom when deciding when to hold a novel study
