bred in the bone and the lyre of orpheus in the rebel angels maria and darcourt alternate in narrating the novel's theme obsession before escaping from its grip by their mutual assistance while other characters are less fortunate what's bred in the bone narrates the artistic development of canadian painter francis cornish which is crowned by his stunning marriage at cana an iconographic presentation of his personal myth a color reproduction of bronzino's allegory exemplifies their stylistic kinship while the lyre of orpheus is ostensibly focused on the completion and staging of an unfinished hoffmann opera it narrates the ameliorative personal development of the characters who interact during that project
