subsequent controversial world tour with a rock n roll band and the recording of his three undisputed electric masterpieces bringing it all back home highway 61 revisited and blonde on blonde at the peak of his fame in july 1966 he reportedly crashes his motorbike in woodstock upstate new york and disappears from public view when he re emerges he looks different his voice sounds different his songs are different clinton heylin s meticulously researched all encompassing and consistently revelatory account of these fascinating early years is the closest we will ever get to a definitive life of an artist who has been the lodestar of popular culture for six decades
