a developmental history of the african american struggle for autonomy and power discusses black slaves and white indentured servants the black founding fathers the relationship between african americans and native americans and other issues

first published in 1986 a collection of studies on black america from 1985 to 1986 inclusing the economic status classes political policies housing education and civil rights includes a population chart of american blacks from 1980 to 1984

recounts the journey of the first generation of african americans stolen from a spanish slave ship and brought to jamestown in 1619 discussing their contributions to the establishment of the young colony and their efforts to purchase freedom and establish communities
