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the financial crisis that began in 2007 triggered a break with banking practices of the past even as the crisis occurred a broader set of economic geopolitical and technological forces were already reshaping the financial industry s transition from the twentieth to the twenty first century while these changes in the financial and global climate have led to a major overhaul of banking regulations and increased scrutiny of banks they have also revealed opportunities for the development of a banking sector fit for the future a new era in banking the landscape after the battle identifies the main drivers of change at the heart of this wholesale transformation of the financial services industry it examines the complex challenge for financial institutions to de risk business models reconnect with customers and approach stakeholder value creation untangling the severe mutations that have taken place in the banking sector a new era in banking contextualizes these changes within larger trends that extend beyond the confines of the financial crisis banks are more vulnerable than ever to the crosscurrents of economic demographic regulatory and technological change however by discussing how banks can operate as flexible technology enabled information businesses a new era in banking advocates financial practices based not only on survival but innovation

this book aims to enrich the banking and finance literature by gathering insights in new research topics being undertaken in the aftermath of the covid 19 pandemic the book spans all the major research fields in finance and banking with a particular focus on corporate governance sustainability and innovation the book brings together academics at a range of european universities and stems from research presented at the 2022 annual conference of the wolpertinger club the first part focuses on the impact of banks corporate governance practice on their performance including pay gaps as well as diversity and esg policies the second part examines how banks are conducting their green transition with topics including reputational risk greenwashing green bonds and esg scores the final section of the book considers the role of digitalization and innovative technologies in creating unprecedented disruption in the banking sector this edited collection is valuable to those researching in finance banking and business as well as policymakers and operational decision makers at financial institutions

about the book banking sector reforms in india are aimed at induction of best international practices and technological changes for competing globally the reserve bank of india rbi has time and again emphasised transparency diversification of ownership and strong corporate governance to mitigate the prospects of systemic risks in the banking sector banking sector reforms have supported the transition of the indian economy to a higher growth path while significantly improving the stability of the financial system in comparison with the pre reform period the indian banking system today is more stable and efficient however the gains of the past decade need to be consolidated so that these could be translated to drive the institutions markets and practices into a mature financial system that can meet the challenges of globalisation the banking system would therefore not only need to be stable but also supportive of still higher levels of planned investments by channelling financial resources more efficiently from surplus to deficit sectors competitive pressures as well as prudential regulatory requirements have made banks risk averse as reflected in their tendency to investment in relatively risk free gilt instruments the behaviour and strategies

of banking business need changes in favour of risk taking even while performing core activities also there is a need to ensure long term finance to support development and growth in the economy even as restructuring takes place through mergers and universal banking the present book addresses issues like basel ii accord guidelines second generation banking sector reforms cost benefit and productivity analysis of indian banks danger zone banks privatisation and comparative efficiency of indian banks and the recent reform measures vital statistics regarding the indian banking sector and the recent annual policy statement 2008 09 of the rbi has also been discussed about the author dr r k uppal did his m a in economics from punjabi university patiala in 1986 thereafter he obtained m phil degree from mdu rohtak in 1987 and ph d degree from punjabi university patiala in 2003 specialising in banking and finance dr uppal has 11 books to his credit and has published 40 research papers on the subject in reputed national and international journals he has also presented more than 35 research papers in national and international conferences in hawaii indonesia finland costa rica australia london and the uk presently he is head of the department of economics dav college malout punjab and principal investigator of a ugc financed research project on indian banking he is also director of an icssr sponsored major research project on indian banking

the banking sector under financial stability recognises the critical importance of the banking sector with respect to financial stability risks and considers the unique position of banks which by nature assume higher risks existing within a low equity to total assets ratio

this book provides an evaluation of the industrial organization of banking with a focus on the interrelationship among bank behavior market structure and regulation it addresses a wide range of public policy topics including bank competition and risk international banking antitrust issues and capital regulation new to this edition which has been updated throughout is a broadened consideration of alternative theories of competition among banks which includes discussions of such issues as the implications of large increases in bank reserve holdings in recent years effects of nonprice competition through quality rivalry analysis of mixed market structures involving both large and small banks and international interactions of banks and policymakers the intent of the book is to serve as a learning tool and reference for graduate students academics bankers and policymakers seeking to better understand the industrial organization of the banking sector and the effects of banking regulations

the latest advancement in financial technology has posed unprecedented challenges for incumbent banks this paper analyzes the implications of these challenges on bank competitiveness and explores the factors that could support digital advancement in banks the analysis shows that the traditionally leading role of banks in advancing financial technology has diminished in recent years and suggests that ongoing efforts to catch up to

the digital frontier could lead to a more concentrated banking industry as smaller and less tech savvy banks struggle to survive cross country evidence has suggested that banks in high income economies appear to have been the digital leaders likely benefiting from a sound digital infrastructure a strong legal and business environment and healthy competition nonetheless some digital leaders may fall behind in the coming years in adopting newer technologies due to entrenched consumer behavior favoring older technologies less active fintech and bigtech companies and weak bank balance sheets

the oxford handbook of banking provides an overview and analysis of state of the art research in banking written by leading researchers in the field this handbook will appeal to graduate students of economics banking and finance academics practitioners and policy makers consequently the book strikes a balance between abstract theory empirical analysis and practitioner and policy related material the handbook is split into five parts part i the theory of banking examines the role of banks in the wider financial system why banks exist how they function and their legal and governance structures part ii entitled regulatory and policy perspectives discusses monetary policy prudential regulation and supervision and antitrust policy part iii deals with bank performance a number of issues are assessed including efficiency financial innovation and technological change globalization and ability to deliver small business consumer and mortgage lending services part iv of the book provides an overview of macroeconomic perspectives in banking this part includes a discussion of the determinants of bank failures and crises and the impact on financial stability institutional development and economic growth part v examines international differences in banking structures and environments this part of the handbook examines banking systems in the united states western europe transition countries latin america japan and the developing nations of asia

the book provides deep insight into the processes of digital transformation of banking according to economic institutional and social dimensions together with the transformation of incumbent banks the processes result in changes in the scope of existing banking services moreover new entities fintech firms partner with incumbent banks and reshape the banking sector and its financial environment the far reaching transformation of banks and the banking sectors is accompanied by some institutional and socioeconomic processes regarding institutional processes the book provides insight into the digitalization of the banking sector from a legal point of view traditionally banking is strongly regulated by norms and rules and this status should be maintained when new entities are entering the sector and or when new technological solutions contribute to the provision of banking services regarding socioeconomic processes it must be highlighted that digitalization is exerting a powerful impact on societies one significant example among others is the increase in the financial inclusion of disadvantaged groups especially customers either underserved by the traditional financial sector or unbanked the socioeconomic aspect however has a much greater dimension and its selected aspects are described in this book the principal audience of the book will be scholars in the fields of banking and finance but also other related disciplines in the social sciences that are of particular relevance to the banking sector s digital transformation this includes legal science management and psychology the book also targets professionals in the financial industry interested in the impact of new financial technologies on banking sectors and bank services particularly with a main focus on legal and socioeconomic dimensions
