a landmark of journalism and the art form of comics based on several months of research and an extended visit to the west bank and gaza strip in the early 1990s this is a major work of political and historical nonfiction

rafah a town at the southernmost tip of the gaza strip is a squalid place raw concrete buildings front rubbish strewn alleys the narrow streets are crowded with young children and unemployed men situated on the border with egypt swaths of rafah have been reduced to rubble rafah is today and has always been a notoious flashpoint in this most bitter of conflicts buried deep in the archives is one bloody

incident in 1956 that left 111 palestinian refugees dead shot by israeli soldiers seemingly a footnote to a long history of killing that day in rafah coldblooded massacre or dreadful mistake reveals the competing truths that have come to define an intractable war in a quest to get to the heart of what happened joe sacco arrives in gaza and immersing himself in daily life uncovers rafah past and present spanning fifty years moving fluidly between one war and the next alive with the voices of fugitives and schoolchildren widows and sheikhs footnotes in gaza captures the essence of a tragedy as in palestine and safe area goravde joe sacco s unique visual journalism has rendered a contested landscape in brilliant meticulous detail footnotes in gaza his most ambitious work to date transforms a critical conflict of our age into intimate and immediate experience
