pulitzer prize winner sylvia plath s complete poetic works edited and introduced by ted hughes by the time of her death on 11 february 1963 sylvia plath had written a large bulk of poetry to my knowledge she never scrapped any of her poetic efforts with one or two exceptions she brought every piece she worked on to some final

form acceptable to her rejecting at most the odd verse or a false head or a false tail her attitude to her verse was artisan like if she couldn't get a table out of the material she was quite happy to get a chair or even a toy the end product for her was not so much a successful poem as something that had temporarily exhausted her ingenuity so this book contains not merely what verse she saved but after 1956 all she wrote ted hughes from the introduction

robinson jeffers 1887 1962 is not only the greatest poet that california and indeed the american west has produced but a major poet of the twentieth century who occupies a prominent place in the tradition of american prophetic poetry jeffers consciously set himself apart from the poetry of his generation by physical isolation at his home in carmel by his unusual poetic form and by his stance as an anti modernist yet his work represents a profound and profoundly original artistic response to problems that shaped modernist poetry and that still perplex poets today how to reconcile scientific and artistic discourses and modes of vision how to connect present day experience to myths perceived as lying at the origins of human culture how to renew the poetic language and how or whether to present art s claim to moral spiritual or epistemological seriousness within representations of modern phenomena for jeffers as for no other important modern american poet there has never been a collected poems not even a truly representative selected poems the current selected poetry first published in 1938 contains no work from the last three volumes published during jeffers lifetime or from his posthumous volume now for the first time all of jeffers completed poems both published and unpublished are presented in a single comprehensive and textually authoritative edition the first three volumes of this four volume work will present chronologically all of jeffers published work from 1920 to 1963 the present volume consists of poems published between 1920 and 1928 and includes some of his greatest and best known poems tamar roan stallion the women at point sur and cawdor as well as a recently discovered long poem home there is also an editorial note and a general introduction

ruth pitter 1897 1992 may not be widely known but her credentials as a poet are extensive in england from the mid 1930s to the mid 1970s she maintained a loyal reader ship in total she produced 17 volumes of new and collected verse her a trophy of arms 1936 won the hawthornden prize for poetry in 1937 and in 1954 she was awarded the william e heinemann award for the ermine 1953 most notably perhaps she became the first woman to receive the queen s gold medal for poetry in 1955 this unprecedented event merited a personal audience with the queen in addition from 1946 to 1972 she was often a guest on bbc radio programs and from

1956 to 1960 she appeared regularly on the bbc s the brains trust one of the first television talk shows her thoughtful comments on the wide range of issues discussed by the panelists were a favorite among viewers in 1974 the royal society of literature elected her to its highest honor a companion of literature and in 1979 she received her last national award when she was appointed a commander of the british empire pitter s many admirers included owen barfield hilaire belloc lord david cecil philip larkin c s lewis kathleen raine may sarton and siegfried sassoon at her death in 1992 one writer claimed she came to enjoy perhaps the highest reputation of any living english woman poet of her century pitter s best poems focus on nature and the human condition taking us to hidden or secret places just beyond the material to the meaning of life her poems are often the result of a heightened sense of felt experience intuitive and evocative if human life is lived behind a veil faintly obscuring reality pitter s poems often lift the edge of the veil sudden heaven arranges pitter s poems in chronological order allowing readers to follow her maturation as a poet and it features a number of poems that have never before appeared in print

jane gentry 1941 2014 possessed an uncanny ability to spin quietly expansive and wise verses from small details objects and remembered moments the hallmarks of her work are insight into nature faith the quotidian and perhaps most prominently the grounding of her home and family in the state of kentucky this innovative poet and critic was for many years one of the animating spirits of literary life in the region gentry and her daughters collaborated with editor julia johnson to organize this definitive collection the result is an important literary anthology that assembles gentry s most celebrated poems alongside new previously unpublished works johnson uses gentry s own methodology to arrange the poems in sequences comparable to those found in her previous collections this organization showcases the range of the poet s work and the flexibility of her style which is sometimes ironic and humorous sometimes poignant but always clear intelligent and revelatory this volume includes two full length collections of poetry in their entirety a garden in kentucky and portrait of the artist as a white pig the final section features gentry s unpublished work bringing together her early poems verses written for loved ones and a large group of more recent work that may have been intended for future collections alternately startling and heart wrenching the new and collected poems of jane gentry offers a valuable retrospective of the celebrated poet s work

winner of the c hugh holman award a central figure in twentieth century american literature robert penn warren 1905 1989 was appointed by the library of congress as the first poet laureate of the united states in 1985 although better known for his fiction especially his novel all the king s men it is mainly his poetry spanning sixty years fifteen volumes of verse and a wide range of styles that reveals warren to be one of america s foremost men of letters in this indispensable volume john burt warren s literary executor has assembled every poem warren ever published with the exception of brother to dragons including the many poems he published in the fugitive and other magazines as well as those that appeared in his small press works and broadsides burt has also exhaustively collated all of the published versions of warren's poems which in some cases appeared as many as six different times with substantive revisions in every line as well as his typescripts and proofs and since warren never seemed to reread any of his books without a pencil in his hand burt has referred to warren s personal library copies this comprehensive edition also contains textual notes lists of emendations and explanatory notes warren was born and raised in guthrie kentucky where southern agrarian values and a predilection for storytelling were ingrained in him as a young boy by 1925 when he graduated from vanderbilt university he was already the most promising of that exceptional set of poets and intellectuals known as the fugitives warren devoted most of the 1940s and 1950s to writing prose and literary criticism but from the late 1950s he composed primarily poetry with each successive volume of verse that he penned demonstrating his rigorous and growing commitment to that genre the mature visionary power and technical virtuosity of his work in the 1970s and early 1980s emanated from his strongly held belief that only insofar as the work of art establishes and expresses a self can it engage us many of warren s later poems which he deemed some of my best rejoice in the possibilities of old age and the poet s ability for continually expanding in a vital process of definition affirmation revision and growth a process that is the image we may say of the life process
