this book examines the way christians in jerusalem prayed and how their prayer changed in the face of foreign invasions and the destruction of their places of worship

this crisp and cogent book by the rev dr strouse is published at a time when both interfaith and intrafaith dialogue are critical to the vitality of spiritual life in our nation as a parish pastor in a small struggling congregation i have become increasingly aware of the insularity and isolation of many of our parishioners this seems less the result of inadequate parish education as it is the byproduct of too many people getting their information from biased tv networks so called social media or word of mouth we parish pastors need to examine our internal intra congregational conversations about diverse faith traditions and how they bear on congregational mission i was particularly impressed by the author s use of footnotes and her extensive bibliography the book is a walking talking workshop in print with its detailed reflection discussion questions and suggestions for further reading thank you pastor strouse for such a comprehensive presentation of how to approach constructively this timely and important conversation review by richard g eddy

written in semi autobiographical style the book intertwines personal testimony scripture and the nature of god the author shows how seemingly trivial or isolated events combine with sad or challenging circumstances over a period of years or even decades to work together for good according to romans 8 28 these same events may be key factors necessary for us to experience in order to fulfill the plans and purposes god has for nations or individuals as described in jeremiah 29 11 the book addresses issues which are either unclear or unmentioned in the bible these include the fate of infants or small children who die before having faith or being baptized what happens to friends relatives or others we love who may have gone through life without knowing christ as their personal savior and entire populations who have never heard of christ over many centuries the book identifies the unpardonable sin in a manner that removes all doubts and questions the book also confronts serious misinterpretation of scripture in what the author calls gods greatest truth or satans greatest deception finally the author compares the commentary on habakkukuncovered in the dead sea scrollsto events in modern history showing that this prophecy of things which were destined for the last generation have been fulfilled additionally he describes in detail another archeological discovery yet to be revealed which can be verified scientifically and will be incontrovertible proof to jews and gentiles alike that god is real and jesus is lord and savior

this book studies the complex attitude of late ancient christians towards classical education in recent years the different theoretical positions that can be found among the church fathers have received particular attention their statements ranged from enthusiastic assimilation to outright rejection the latter sometimes masking implicit adoption shifting attention away from such explicit statements this volume focuses on a series of lesser known texts in order to study the impact of specific literary and social contexts on late ancient educational views and practices by moving attention from statements to strategies this volume wishes to enrich our understanding of the creative engagement with classical ideals of education the multi faceted approach adopted here illuminates the close connection between specific educational purposes on the one hand and the possibilities and limitations offered by specific genres and contexts on the other instead of seeing attitudes towards education in late antique texts as applications of theoretical positions it reads them as complex negotiations between authorial intent the limitations of genre and the context of performance
