which we play a minor part barely influencing natural outcomes or one that is more actively managed and provides for our needs or wants neither this volume nor the conference from which it draws resolve the paradoxes described above the papers presented here do however provide insight into the innovative thinking and practical projects undertaken across the globe that move us from patently unsustainable conditions to those in which our economic activity impact on ecosystems and desire for positive social outcomes are in better balance
